



Memorandum of Understanding
on
The Technical Exchange Programme
Between



Metropolitan Waterworks Authority (MWA), Kingdom of Thailand
and
Osaka Water Supply Authority (OWSA), Japan

This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as "MOU") confirms that the Metropolitan Waterworks Authority (hereinafter referred to as "MWA"), which is located at 400 Prachachuen Road, Lakxi, Bangkok 10210, Thailand, and the Osaka Water Supply Authority (hereinafter referred to as "OWSA"), which is located at 2-3-12, Tanimachi, Chuo-ku, Osaka 540-0012, Japan, have reached the agreement as follows.

1. Purpose

MWA and OWSA undertake to enhance the skills, experiences, and knowledge of their staff mainly by means of technical exchanges, aiming to further the development of waterworks for both parties.

2. Details of Technical Exchanges

The details of technical exchanges under this MOU shall be determined every year by negotiation between both parties after the conclusion of this MOU.

3. Burden of Expenses

The burden of expenses associated with technical exchanges between both parties shall be placed as follows:

- The expenses of travel and living shall be borne by the party that dispatches its staff.
- The expenses of site inspection and training shall be borne by the party that accepts visitors.
- The burden of other expenses shall be determined by negotiation between both parties.
- In the case that a financial support from other organizations can be obtained, it shall be allotted for the expenses associated with technical exchanges.

This MOU will be in effect from the date of execution. In witness whereof, it has been executed in duplicate, with both parties holding one copy each after being signed and sealed.
